Include your personal artistic goals and career plans.  $\_$  2. **A binder-style portfolio** with 6 (six) - 10 (ten) photographs of your work with descriptive narrative. You should represent the range of both your visual style and your mastery of media. These works should have been completed within the last 2 (two) years. \_\_\_\_ 3. One personal photograph approximately 3" x 4". The Guild may use the photo for publicity if you are awarded the scholarship. 4. Two letters of recommendation: one from an art teacher and one from another faculty member or non-related person who knows you. \_ 5. **Two pieces of original art work** to be displayed (with the portfolio) at the Guild's Spring Art Show at the Civic Center during Western Art Week, March 14-16, 2024.
