The purpose of this award is to provide funds for graduating seniors from any accredited high school located in Great Falls, Montana. As stated in Ralph Haugse's Last Will and Testament, deserving students were to be selected by a scholarship committee and school principal based on: 1) economic need; 2) intention of being a full-time student; 3) maintenance of at least an overall "B" average freshman through senior year of high school. The scholarship is calculated at 75% of the average published expense of tuition, fees, room, and board at MSU and UM for the school year.

Eligibility requirements for Years 2, 3, and 4: 1) Student has maintained not less than a C average while attending college or university; 2) Student has carried at least 12 credits per semester; 3) recipient must be financially in need of assistance as measured by State of Montana Financial Aid Office; 4) student has been attending a college or university for consecutive years without a lapse in attendance for any intervening school year or years.

Please type this application and **return it to the Advisement Center by March 20, 2020**, along with three letters of recommendation from employers, teachers, or civic leaders; a 250-word essay discussing your plans for college and beyond; a copy of your 7th semester transcript; and a copy of the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) from your completed FAFSA form.
