FAFSA INFO...

The wait is almost over! The FAFSA Simplification Act has delayed the release of FAFSA forms. To plan ahead and be ready when forms are released, start with the following:

1. Create a FAFSA ID
2. Know your Social Security Number
3. Have your Driver's License Number (if applicable)
4. Student's & Parent's 2022 Federal Income Taxes
5. Records of Untaxed Income (if applicable)
6. Records of assets (if applicable)
7. List of schools you are interested in
