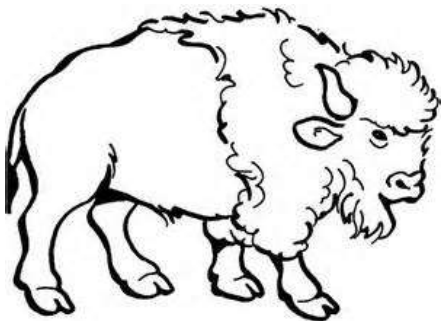

DUAL CREDIT: Students enrolled in a dual credit course at GFH will not only earn credit on their high school transcript, but also on a college transcript from the awarding college or university. Please note that the grade earned on the high school transcript will be the grade printed on the college transcript. In order to earn college credit, students will need to pay fees to the specific post-secondary institution, fulfill the requirements set by the college in the dual credit agreement, and meet pre-requirements. Fees vary.

ADVANCE PLACEMENT

PROGRAM: Students enrolled in AP Courses are in a college-level class taught at the high school. The culmination of this class (and the opportunity to earn college credit in addition to high school credit) is the AP exam given in the spring. Many colleges and/or universities give credit for students who, on the AP test, earn a specific score acceptable at individual institutions. The 2018 AP test fee was \$94.

DUAL ENROLLMENT (COLLEGE CREDIT ONLY):

College level remedial courses do not qualify for the tuition discount.
